Managers-

Thank you very much for volunteering to manage a team this season, we greatly appreciate it. One of the many responsibilities that come with proud title of Manager is to supply two trained umpires for your team's home games, though visiting team often covers the Field Umpire position. You umpires will need to be trained and able to cover both the Home Plate and Field Umpire positions.

Home Plate Umpire - balls/strikes, fair/foul, catch/ no catch, and game management

Field Umpire – base runners and plays in the field

Sno-Valley North will provide local training opportunities in addition to the in-depth training offered through **WA Little League District-9**.* There will be classroom as well as field (or gym) sessions available to educate and refresh everyone from the rookie umpires to the seasoned veterans.

Your team will be provided one set of home plate umpire gear in addition to clickers, jerseys, and hats for the volunteers.

As you are asking for team parents, score keepers, assistant coaches, don't forget or neglect the need for volunteer umpires. This is a great opportunity for the parents, guardians, and siblings to give back even more to their player and community while experiencing the game from a different point of view.
