

Umpire In Chief

The Umpire in Chief is the official field playing rules interpreter for the League and shall render all official protest decisions. The Umpire in Chief shall oversee the educating and training of all potential league umpires, making sure that they are qualified in the basic skill necessary for the officiating before being given any real game assignments, schedule or cause to be scheduled umpires for each game on the schedule.

In addition, the Umpire in Chief will assist/support all league events as part of the CGS Executive Board of Volunteers, attend regularly scheduled board meetings and vote as necessary in all CGS board elections.

Duties include:

- Oversee the arrangement for and scheduling of umpires for all regular and make-up games.
- Insure that all umpires are ASA registered and promotes ASA umpire certification.
- Schedule the umpiring clinic, which will include league policy, rules of the game, basic mechanics, testing and dress code.
- With Player Agent establish supplementary rules specific for each division.
- Work with Coaches Agent in setting up Umpires/Managers/ Coaches meetings.
- Obtain and facilitate distribution of the official rulebooks, and supplementary rules to each team.
- Monitor the umpires throughout the season. Shall fill out an evaluation on each umpire at the season end as to his or her suitability to be considered as a returning umpire the next year. Any problems or attributes that happen during the year shall also be noted. The evaluations are to be kept in strict confidence and should only be used in determining if someone should not be allowed to return as an umpire in subsequent years. These evaluations shall be turned in to the President when completed.
