Managing is a privilege and not a right. Managers selected are a reflection upon CGS and our community.

MANAGERS AND COACHES: WHAT'S THE DIFFERENCE??: The Manager of a softball team is like a manager in business. The Manager is responsible for communicating with players and parents, to keep them informed of practice times, game times, and any other pertinent information pertaining to the season. The Manager is responsible for the entire team and puts the pieces in place on the team and on the field. He/she gathers up the pieces, through evaluations or tryouts, decides what positions they'll play and when, and shuffles the pieces when the original plan doesn't work. He/she is continually involved in the development and teaching of each and every player. The Manager is responsible for thoroughly knowing ASA/USA and CGS rules.

Coaches help the Manager and work alongside the Manager at practices and games, under the Manager's methodology. Coaches focus on a player's well being and improving their performance. When the Manager is absent, a coach may assume the Manager's role for a practice or game. Teams typically have at least two coaches in addition to the Manager. More coaches may be necessary on younger teams (6U or 8U) to help further develop players.

- ❖ The Manager must adhere to CGS Rules to ensure all players are treated fairly, have the opportunity to learn the fundamentals of softball and learn good sportsmanship.
- ❖ A signed Coach's Code of Conduct and Background Check Form, with a copy of your driver's license attached, must be included with this application.
