July Full Contact Camp 7/20 – 7/23

The Bel Air Terps will once again be hosting our annual Summer Full Contact Camp.

This camp is designed to help football players between the ages of 5 - 14 prepare for the rigors of August in full pads and helmet. This camp is a full contact camp that will feature skills and drills that center around proper techniques for running, blocking and tackling.

This camp is administered and staffed by Bel Air Terps coaches and volunteers, but is open to any player regardless of program or league affiliation. Each player registered will receive a camp T-shirt. Cost for this camp is \$75 per player. This camp will be held at Tucker Field each night, starting at 6 PM, and running until 8 PM.
