President's Report – Scott Snyder

- Low numbers for registration; upside down last month
- Federal I90 done – needs to be mailed in

Old business:

- Latham Scholarship
 - o Only 1 application received from a past SPYA softball player – scholarship will be awarded to her

New business:

- Background Checks – Softball has not turned any in; probably too late for this season – Soccer, Football and Cheer will be required to do them
- Board Member Vote – Scott Snyder has chosen to not call for a vote for the new members at this time

Commissioner Reports

Baseball – Jim Chrapowicz

- All in house and ULM teams are complete. ULM had 1 team with regular season title (AA-Hawley)
- 14 of 21 teams in ULM made the playoffs; but none won

- 2 of 3 in LVL made the playoffs; 1 has been eliminated, the other still playing
- CM/JL/SL are still playing
- Lottery fundraiser is complete – easily the most successful baseball fundraiser in a few years
- Uniform and equipment return scheduled for later in July
- Registration for fall baseball season is closed. Equipment and uniforms have been ordered.

Basketball – Mark Constant

- Mark is working with his coordinators to begin planning the 2010 season

Cheerleading – Kerrie Armbruster

- Camp was run the last 2 weeks of school
- Investigating cheer mats
- Preparing and distributing uniforms

Football – Sean Gill

- 223 registrations to date; only down 6
- 60 camp registrations - \$4800 in income – July 12-16th, permits in hand
- Hot dogs and burgers in warehouse will be used for the camp
- Needs new tent for concessions for the season
- Golf outing 9/26 as a fundraiser
- Waiting for UMT to approve use of lights at Grange
- Equipment order is in
- Asking SWT for Port-a-potties at CBP/WD
- Scrimmages scheduled; also entered into a tournament
- Parents ordered 26 new helmets for their players; SPYA will not need to provide helmets for those players

Soccer – Drew Johnston

- Registrations continue; 350 to date; still receiving calls and emails about registering
- Travel – hoping for 9-11 teams for fall season; this is an increase from spring; teams entered in the LVYSL; season starts 9/11/10
- NVYSL – teams are being formed; season starts 9/11 or 9/12
- In House – teams are being formed
- Coaches Education is in the planning stages
- Games are tentatively planned to begin 9/11 for all levels
- Equipment orders are being formed and placed for fall season. Plan to move SPYA goals currently at WD to Lone Lane due to increased field needs
- Fields – planning to rotate fields this summer to protect goal areas and increased demand for field space; also met with representatives of PASC

Softball – Bill Novak (via written report)

- PL season done
 - o Two 10U teams made playoffs, one lost the championship game
 - o 14U made playoffs
 - o 18U made playoffs and lost championship series
 - o All start games this weekend (7/10) at Northwestern
- LVL regular season done

- 12U was regular season champs, playoffs start this week
- Equipment and uniforms are being collected
- Settling up season expenses with coaches
- Lottery fundraiser in progress (~1900 in sales, 275 paid out to date)
- Tractor repaired
- Search continues for new commissioner

- Will be issuing new codes and new keys
