



Rebels Travel Softball Commitment

Travel softball requires a deeper commitment from player and parents versus rec (or house) softball.

In order to be considered to be rostered on our 2020 teams:

Travel softball requires a deeper commitment from players and parents versus rec softball.

- In order to be considered to be rostered on our 2020 teams, players and parents must be able to play every weekend from April 1st (for high school players, you are eligible to play with travel teams once released from your HS program, usually in late May through early June) to August 2nd (FCFSL season-ending championships/college showcases), as well as, games and practices during the week.
- You must also plan for up to 2 overnight tournaments in Northeast locations (within 3-hour drive from Ridgefield). Possibly more for 16U/18U teams.
- We generally carry rosters of 12 to 14 players per team to maximize playing time throughout the season which is one of the reasons this commitment level is required, as it is with all other travel softball programs (and other sports) in the region.
- We, and other travel programs ask that you make vacation plans starting after August 2nd.

If a player cannot make this level of commitment up to the season-ending FCFSL tournament, we will not be able to offer a roster spot on a Rebels travel softball team.
