

Dear Parent:

Your player has been chosen to participate in the **3rd/4th Grade NSYL Honor Game** held at Starfire Sports Complex on May 25th; as part of the **Washington State Boys High School Lacrosse Championships**. The information below describes what is expected of players.

- 1) All players must check-in at the **North VIP Entrance** (see attached map) to Starfire Sports Complex, 14800 Starfire Way, Tukwila, WA 98188 at **10:00 a.m.** It is important that your player is on time.
- 2) Coaches will escort players onto the field at **10:25 a.m.**
 - A) Players will need to bring all required protective equipment:
 - i. Helmet, shoulder pads, arm guards
 - ii. Mouth guard and athletic cup.
 - iii. Water bottle
 - iv. Goalies need to bring their goalie gear.
 - v. Multiple position players should be prepared to play any position.
 - B) Your league will instruct you on what uniform to bring.
- 3) The game is scheduled for two 25 minute, running clock, halves with a five-minute warm-up and five minute half-time.
- 4) After the game, coaches will escort players off the field and back to the player staging area, where parents can meet their player(s). Please do not congregate on the field so that the next games can be started on time.
- 5) Parents will be asked to purchase tickets through general admission; Adults are \$10.00, Students are \$7.00 and children 5 and under are free. Players will receive a day pass upon check-in. There is also a small parking fee collected by Starfire. Both admission fees and parking fees are good all day.
- 6) Spectators should remain on the opposite side of the field from the team. Those wishing to take photos of their child are encouraged to do so but should stay clear of the team sidelines and the area directly behind the goals.
