



Evanston Youth Hockey Association: Coaches Code of Conduct

The following Code of Conduct applies to all Evanston Youth Hockey Association (EYHA) coaches.

1. Coaches will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, fans, volunteers and officials, and conduct themselves in a professional manner at all times.
2. Coaches will treat players, parents, fans, officials, other coaches, opponents and facilities with respect.
3. Coaches will refrain from using abusive language around players.
4. Coaches will be responsible for the conduct of their players, both on and off the ice.
5. Coaches will not physically or verbally abuse any player.
6. Coaches will treat disciplinary problems in accordance with the infraction and individual involved.
7. Coaches will give credit to players when they win as well as when they lose, criticizing them only in their presence.
8. Coaches will update players and parents on the player's performance, skills, strengths and weaknesses.
9. Coaches will not allow any bullying or misconduct by any player and are responsible for enforcing and reporting violations to the EYHA Rules & Ethics Committee as per the Zero Tolerance policy.
10. Coaches will maintain strict discipline in the locker room before and after practice and games. Coaches will be available to monitor the locker room before and after games/practices or will find an appropriate designate to do so.
11. Coaches will comply with the EYHA Locker Room policy.
12. Coaches will comply with the EYHA Social Media policy.
