IV	<p><u>Treasurer's Report– Rhonda Peischl</u></p> <p>A. Rhonda provided an updated snapshot of the monthly finances for Mason Men's Lacrosse. She discussed expenses that are still outstanding including the MW Tournament Hotel charges, Hudson Trip, FAST Payment, Coaches salaries, Senior Dinner & Night expenses. Rhonda estimates these expenses to be approximately \$8,000. Overall the event was a success, thank you to all the volunteers and especially Roger Harrison and DeAnna Malloy for providing their referee expertise to the event. Rachel noted the following recommendations for next year:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Limit the number of teams, with the large number of teams this year the Championship wasn't until 3:55a and they played until after 4am when the After Prom was over. - Do NOT play any games during mandatory prize drawing – 2 players were on the court during the prize announcements and therefore had to forfeit their prizes. - Set up for the event on Saturday morning, not Friday evening <p>C. Youth Night Youth Night was a huge success, feedback from the Youth Coaches was extremely positive. Allowing the boys to be on the field for the National Anthem and to tour the locker rooms was very popular. Also, the jerseys for the halftime game were greatly appreciated. We also had Taco Night that night, which was also a big hit with the fans, we sold over 560 tacos. Unfortunately, although this is a fan favorite, it is not profitable for the club.</p> <p>D. The general consensus was that the parents liked the introductions at the beginning of the game rather than at halftime, it was less rushed and they were able to relax and enjoy the game. VI	<p><u>New Business</u></p> <p>A. Playoffs As the #2 Seed in the playoffs, Mason is guaranteed the next 3 home games if they continue to win. Therefore we will need concession signups for May 17, May 20 and May 24th. DeAnna will send out a Sign Up Genius in attempts to get workers and a drink order will need to be placed for at least the first game. End Of Season Banquet The Banquet is tentatively scheduled for May 31st, this may need to be rescheduled if the team goes to the Final Four playoff game as that will be held on the 31st of May. DeAnna will research catering options with Putters and Carrabas.</p> <p>D. Concessions/ Team Dinners/Guest Team Meals– DeAnna Malloy -DeAnna would like to look more closely at Concession prices as they have remained the same for the last several years, although supply prices have increased. Her and Rosemary will take a look at the prices and consider raising some of them incrementally to make up for increased supply costs. -Team Dinners and Pop-Ups have all been a huge success this year. Rosemary would like to be more selective with Pop-Ups next year, however overall they were a success and loved by the boys and coaches. A Huge Thank You to Rosemary for securing so many fantastic meals and reaching out to so many sponsors this year. A huge thank you to the Team Dinner staff of Marcia Croy, Jen Aaron, Rachel Harrison and Suzanne Smith – they were at every Team Dinner to make sure that everything ran smoothly. - Rosemary would like to make sure a review is had around Feeding teams that travel over 60 miles, as this gets expensive. Perhaps we can rely more on parents to supply sides/desserts and the Boosters can provide the main course.
