

**HHS FOOTBALL DRUG AND ALCOHOL POLICY**

Experience and research has proven that even small amounts of narcotics or alcohol can impair judgment and physical responses that can create unsafe conditions for students. These substances also cause adverse effects on athletic performance. Drug using athletes are a threat to themselves, other students and co-participants. HHS Football has a policy that student-athletes must remain substance free.

1. All student athletes are prohibited from using, possessing or distributing controlled substances. Improperly used medications or mood/mind altering substances are also prohibited.
2. All student-athletes are prohibited from possessing, drinking or being impaired by alcohol.
3. After school hour's use of drugs, alcohol or any other prohibited substances is prohibited. Student-athletes should realize that these regulations prohibit all illicit drug use/possession during and away from school.

Players will be subjected to announced and unannounced drug testing throughout the course of the year. Any positive test result will carry the following consequences:

First violation: Suspension of 2 games and removed from all team activities until suspension has been completed. Must test negative on next drug test and complete 800 yards of grass drills before reinstatement.

Second violation: Student-athlete will be dismissed from team for the remainder of the season. Student-athlete may try-out the next year if and only if they test negative from all prohibited substances on all given drug tests before try-outs AND student has had no alcohol/drug incidents since being dismissed from team.

**HHS FOOTBALL DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING PROGRAM**

The above programs will offer voluntary drug and alcohol testing. All test results will be confidential. Urinalysis will be used and collection will be on site (HHS). All initial positive specimens will be confirmed by gaschromatography/mass spectrometry (gc/ms). Parents will be notified on all positive responses. The above programs will conduct unannounced screening for all participating team members in season and/or out of season. Positive results from the testing will have the same penalties as listed above the first violation and second violation.
