

# Nassau County Lions Protocols for Return to Play 2021

Cantiague Park • Hicksville, N.Y.

*The following guidance applies to the games scheduled at Cantiague Park in Hicksville between the Nassau County Lions and their respective opponents. This guidance has been approved by the Nassau County Board of Health and must be strictly adhered to in order to take part in travel ice hockey games at Cantiague Park. These rules must be reviewed and agreed upon by both the home and visiting teams prior to play. Any violation of these rules is subject to the game not being played.*

- There will be NO spectators allowed inside Cantiague Park.
- Entry for opposing teams will be through Door "B," located South West corner of the facility.
- Locker Rooms WILL NOT be in use, as players need to be dressed prior to entering rink. Gloves, helmets and skates need to be put on once inside the rink.
- All persons entering the rink MUST wear a mask AT ALL TIMES.
- Masks are to be worn on the bench by the coaches at all times.
- COVID Forms will need to be printed and completed. You will receive this form at the time of game confirmation.
- Access to rink will be 15 minutes prior to game time.
- All team personnel MUST vacate the rink within 15 minutes after the conclusion of the game.
- ONLY rostered players and coaches (USA Hockey Roster) will be permitted inside the facility.
- All visiting coaches should have cellphone numbers for all parents of their players so that in the event of an emergency, they can be contacted immediately. In such cases, the parent would be given access to the rink to assist their child.
- Abuse of staff by coaches or parents will not be tolerated, and the offending parties will be subject to removal from the building.
- ONLY ONE Mite and Squirt parent per player will be permitted to enter the building with a completed COVID Form to assist their child in getting their skates on. Once the player is completely dressed, the parent will have to leave the building. After the game is over, the coaches will assist the players in getting their skates off and the players will be able to exit the building. No parent will be permitted back into the facility to assist in getting players undressed.
