

# Nassau County Lions Protocols for Return to Play 2021

Cantiague Park • Hicksville, N.Y.

*The following guidance applies to the games scheduled at Cantiague Park in Hicksville between the Nassau County Lions and their respective opponents. This guidance has been approved by the Nassau County Board of Health and must be strictly adhered to in order to take part in travel ice hockey games at Cantiague Park. These rules must be reviewed and agreed upon by both the home and visiting teams prior to play. Any violation of these rules is subject to the game not being played.*

- **Players will arrive 15 minutes prior to the start time at their designated Door "A" or "B," dressed in uniform without their skates with their coaches.**
- **COVID Waivers are required for all players, parents and guest spectators who enter the facility.**
- **Parents and spectators will be allowed to enter Cantiague Park through the main lobby ONLY. Upon entry, they are to check in at the table with the rink staff and fill out/present their COVID Waiver Form.**
- **Spectators are to sit in the designated area in the bleacher only, properly wear a mask, and must socially distance at all times. No one is allowed to view the game near the glass.**
- **Spectators are to exit the facility IMMEDIATELY at the conclusion of the game through the main lobby.**
- **Parents and spectators can pick up their child/player at either Door "A" or Door "B" when dismissed by their coaches.**
- **Locker Rooms WILL NOT be in use, as players need to be dressed prior to entering rink. Gloves, helmets and skates need to be put on once inside the rink.**
- **Masks are to be worn on the bench by the coaches at all times.**
- **COVID Forms will need to be printed and completed. You will receive this form at the time of game confirmation.**
- **Abuse of staff by coaches or parents will not be tolerated, and the offending parties will be subject to removal from the building.**
- **ONLY ONE Mite (8U) and Squirt (10U) parent per player will be permitted to enter the building with a completed COVID Form to assist their child in getting their skates on. Once the player is completely dressed, the parent will have to leave the building. After the game is over, the coaches will assist the players in getting their skates off and the players will be able to exit the building.**
