New Rule Proposal

Revision to Existing Rule – Current Rule Number 4.1.4

Description of Rule or Revision (list existing if revision):

DELETE RULE

4.1.4. Head coach must provide a roster of their players to the opposing coach prior to the start of the game. Roster must include at a minimum: team name and division, player first name, last initial, and jersey number. Failure to provide a roster will be reported to the respective VP by coach and result in loss of possession on opening faceoff\draw. Second violation results in a forfeit. If a team has members “playing up” that day, then the coach should also provide a roster from that player’s primary team or list the team the player is on.

Purpose or Reason for Change:

This rule adds additional burden to the head coach and does not enforce what was intended by this rule. A roster does not tell the coach ‘who should be there and who is from a different team’.

NOTE: Proposed Rules or Revisions must be submitted and received by the NHYLA President before the regularly scheduled November Meeting of the NHYLA. Proposals will be put on the agenda and discussed at the November Meeting and voted upon at the December Meeting. Towns must attend all 3 meetings between September and November to be eligible to vote. Rule revisions require a 60% majority vote to be adopted.
