Student Manager Responsibilities

To co-ordinate and support all on and off field football activities for their assigned teams to ensure that all players and coaching and support staff are provided with the highest level of support to enable them to compete and perform at the highest level in 6A football.

Additionally, to work with the non-competitive projects, such as Bruin ACT Projects, Brentwood Boogie, and other events to learn and support the operations of managing a successful football program away from campus.

Finally, to represent BHS and Bruin Football in all aspects of our lives with self-discipline, hard work and character and to be an essential part of our Bruin Nation and Team Brentwood.

Pre-Season (Starting July 19th)

Summer Practice (starts July 22)

- Daily Practice – injury support with Jay Moore, water station set-up, equipment repair, equipment distribution support, water station take-down, field preparation and coach support (managers are expected 20 minutes prior to practice start times and 15 minutes after event wrap-up to support post-practice needs of coaches)
- 7 on 7 Events – injury support with Jay Moore, game preparation (water, Gatorade, field supplies, equipment box for in-game repairs, post-game support for both players and facilities)
- Scrimmages - injury support with Jay Moore, game preparation (water, Gatorade, field supplies, equipment box for in-game repairs, pre and post-game support for both players and facilities)
- Work sideline for both home and away scrimmages
- Statistical and Technology support based on aptitude and capabilities upon a coach's request
- Dress Code:
 - All managers are expected to wear athletic footwear and sock. Team T-Shirt and Shorts to be provided by Bruin Football.
 - Managers are to be as uniformed as the players they are supporting as they are a part of the Bruin Football team.

During Season (Starting August 23rd)

Season Responsibilities (Monday Night and Friday Night Units)

- Daily Practice – injury support with Jay Moore, water station set-up, equipment repair, equipment distribution support, water station take-down, field preparation and coach support (managers are expected 20 minutes prior to practice start times and 15 minutes after event wrap-up to support post-practice needs of coaches)
- Monday Night Unit – These will be Freshman and JV games. All essential pre-game and post-game roles and responsibilities must be performed and supported by Monday Student Manager unit.
 - Uniform for Events: Khaki shorts or Slacks and black sneakers. Polos and hats to be provided by Bruin Football.
- Friday Night Unit – Varsity Game. . All essential pre-game and post-game roles and responsibilities must be performed and supported by Friday Student Manager unit (student managers may request both unit assignments).

- Uniform for Events: Khaki shorts or Slacks and black sneakers. Polos and hats to be provided by Bruin Football.

Post Season

Closure of 2013 Season

- Receive and inspect all equipment in preparation of Spring Football
- Inventory all equipment with coaches
- Inventory medical supplies and work with Jay Moore for 2014 needs for Head Coaches budget
- Prepare written report of "best practices" and " areas to improve" for both coaches and trainers
- Attend and be a part of the End of Season Football Banquet
 - All student managers that successfully meet the job requirements of the season will be eligible to letter and Senior gifts.

Relationships

All Student Managers are official members of the Bruin Football program with all the rights and privileges that come with that association. As such, all student managers will be held to the same standards as all members of the Bruin Football Program.

Student Managers will work directly with student athletes, coaches and trainers. They will contribute to the special requests of the administration, athletic department and 12th Man Club.

Student Managers may also interact with visiting coaches and training staffs, parents and game night support staff (ie, WBHS, Band, etc upon a coach's request)

Accountability

Student Managers report directly to assigned coaches or training staff and ultimately to Head Coach Woodward.

- Based on season roles and responsibilities, some student managers will work directly with Jay Moore and Dr. Arthur, equipment coaches or game preparation coaches. Those assignments will come as the season begins.
