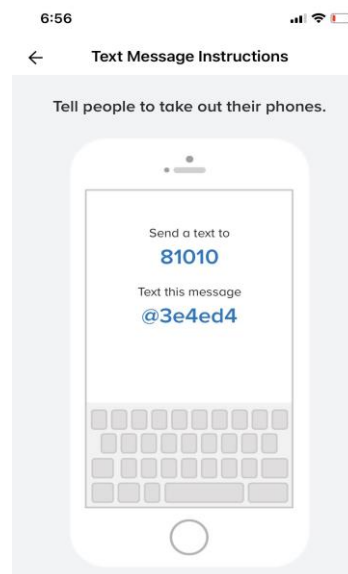

We are tasked with providing a snack and dinner for the boys on **away** game days. We give them a drink before the game. We ensure that a **drink with a resealable lid per** athlete is provided before the game. After the game, we provide them with a light dinner.

DINNER: These items can be ordered ahead of time with prepayment and can be delivered in a pinch. Ideally, a parent at the game will deliver food to the team after a game. Boys will eat whatever is in front of them, so this dinner is not meant to quell their insatiable appetites, just take the edge off. Subway sandwiches, Qdoba, Chick-fil-a sandwiches are all popular choices. The individually wrapped food item, plus pre-packaged chips, 2 packages of fruit snacks and another drink.

LOGISTICS: Drinks, fruit snacks, and chips are purchased ahead of time and prepared in game boxes to be distributed along with the individually wrapped food items. Also, in the game boxes there are trash bags so that nothing is left at the field or on the bus.

Overview:

- 1) Pick up the game box of chips, drinks, and fruit snacks from the team committee lead.
- 2) Deliver drinks to the bus. (One per athlete)
- 3) Call ahead to an area vendor to place an order.
- 4) Money wise, you can save receipts for reimbursement.
- 5) Confirm dinner order is being prepared and paid for.
- 6) After the end of the game team meeting, distribute food and drinks, everyone should get an equal share.
- 7) Turn in receipts to Treasurer (any way you want, phone photo, in person, mail)
- 8) Enjoy the praises and thanks of a grateful team!
