Draft Rules:

Draft rules below are reviewed and approved by the Commissioners and the PSA Board they are Non-negotiable and must be followed.

1. Players Grades 1st thru 12th (6-18 Yr. Olds) will tryout to provide an assessment of their ability to give a base line for coaches during the draft, all players that are registered for the season WILL be drafted on a team. If Players miss tryouts PSA will determine if the draft will continue or if another tryout is needed because of players that missed the draft.
2. Tryouts will evaluate individual skills for each specific sport. Results will be on the draft sheet to help coaches with their choices.
3. Only Head Coaches will draft their teams. Any exception to this rule must be approved by PSA.
4. If possible, team rosters will be 12 Players Maximum.
5. Coaches can only draft 1 Player that has a team sponsor. Picking up 2 players with sponsors and then trying to trade will not be allowed.
6. Draft Rounds will be determined by the number of teams in that age group.
7. Head Coaches kids will draft in the round they fall in.
8. Siblings will be placed on the same team, this will be identified on the draft sheet. There are no other rules for any other players that want to play together or a player/parent that want to play for a specific coach.
9. The only guarantee PSA will give is Head Coaches will draft their child. If the Head Coach does not have a child but they are coaching for a specific player, they will be considered their child for the draft.
10. Coaches will draw numbers one time to determine the draft order. They will draft in order once the last team drafts a player it will go back up starting with the last coach again. In Leagues that have two age groups coaches will not draw numbers again between age groups, the draft order will begin again but in reverse order. On the first age group they draft coaches will draft until all teams have an equal number of players if there are still a few players left in that age group they will be drafted at the end of the draft.
11. Dropping down, on rounds 1-5 coaches can only drop down 1 full point (example if the last player in the 1st round is a 1.66 they can drop down and pick up a 2.66 or a better. After the 5th round coaches can drop down in any round they choose.

12. Trades will be on a case by case basis and approved by the PSA Board
13. If PSA allows a player to register late after the draft the PSA Board will determine which team that player will be on at random. Just because a team would have had the next pick does not mean they will receive that late registered player.
14. If there are players that are older than their peers in their current grade, then the PSA Board will decide after tryouts if they will be moved up to play with players their age.
