## Parents Code of Ethics

I hereby pledge to provide positive support, care, and encouragement for my child participating in Petal Sports Association by following this Parents' Code of Ethics:

I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, and officials at every game, practice or other PSA events.

I will place the emotional and physical wellbeing of my child ahead of my personal desire to win.

I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.

I will refrain from the use of tobacco and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all PSA events.

I will remember that the game is for youth - not adults.

I will ask my child to treat other players, coaches, fans and officials with respect regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.

I will help my child enjoy the youth sports experience by doing whatever I can, such as being a respectful fan, assisting with coaching, or providing transportation.

At PSA, the Board will take a no tolerance approach to the above. If an official or a PSA official throws you out of a game, you must leave the complex immediately. You will be suspended from the complex for a time to be determined by the PSA Board. Depending on the severity of the offense this may result in suspension for the remainder of the season
