Parents and Visitors,

As you are probably aware by now, the school system has construction improvement projects that are ongoing at Vestavia Hills Elementary Cahaba Heights. The project at the north end of the campus is a building addition that consists of new classrooms, a media center, art room, administrative offices and support spaces. This addition is necessary due to the growing population in Vestavia Hills, specifically in the Cahaba Heights community.

As part of this improvement, construction must take place adjacent to the access drive and parking for the north ball fields at the Cahaba Heights Athletic Fields Park. While not ideal, construction activities must occasionally take place during the same times that practices or games are held to ensure the schedule can be met to open this addition when needed. When practices or games are ongoing at the same time as construction activities, we ask that you please follow the safe practices listed below to ensure your safety:

- Be aware of your surroundings as you drive and walk through the area adjacent to the construction site. There is only one way in and one way out to the parking lots for the north fields.
- Pay attention to construction activities and personnel as you enter this area. Look left, look right, look up and look down.
- Please listen to any warnings or instruction that construction personnel give you. They are giving you this information to ensure that you do not get hurt.
- Only park in the gravel lots that are adjacent to the fields. Please do not park along the construction fencing or behind the school. This area is being reserved for ADA drop-off, construction parking and school deliveries.

We ask that you please follow these requests to ensure the safety of your family while you are visiting the parks. This is an important project for our school system and our top priority is to keep everyone safe while it is being built.
