

- Players cannot play on more than one team unless approval by TBKC staff. Girls are permitted to play on boys' teams, but boys may not play on girls' teams.
- A team representative must check-in with the TBKC staff no less than 15 minutes prior to their first scheduled game time to confirm enough participants to play and that the roster is correct. Only players who are registered for the tournament, have a valid KSYSA/US Youth Soccer player card and have signed the Thunder Beach Sand Soccer KC participant waiver are eligible to participate. Teams who participate with players who are not registered, have not completed a TBKC waiver, and/or are not insured through KSYSA/US Youth Soccer, will forfeit all games that included that participant.
- Once at the field, referees will check in teams prior to each contest with a roster provided by the TBKC staff. Additional players may only be written onto the roster with authorization by TBKC staff. Players will be asked to provide KSYSA or US Youth Soccer player cards prior to match.
- For more information surrounding rosters, please see a TBKC staff member.
- A maximum of 6 players may be on a roster. There will NOT be a goalkeeper.
- Sand/Beach soccer balls will NOT be provided for practice or warm-ups.
- Sand/Beach soccer ball will be provided for game.
- Team will forfeit if they have not arrived at their field 5 minutes after the scheduled kickoff time.
- Sand socks are permitted and encouraged, no soccer cleats or athletic shoes permitted.
- Please do not wear any jewelry. No tape over jewelry, jewelry must be removed.
- The Tournament will include 3 pool play games, then to semi-final and finals.
- Games will consist of two 10-minute halves, with a two-minute halftime. Teams will defend one goal in the first half, and the opposite goal in the second half.
- In the event of a tie at the end of regulation time in a pool play games, the game will be over. Any semi-final or final game, sudden-death overtime will be played, with the first team to score being declared the winner.
- Penalty Cards: Players receiving a red card will miss the remainder of that game as well as the following game. Additional suspensions may occur if the TBKC tournament staff deems necessary. There is no yellow card accumulation.
- In the event of bad weather, the TBKC tournament staff will make decisions at the field with decisions posted via email, on the website and social media.
- FIFA: Beach Soccer rules apply except as modified below:
- Slide Tackling is permitted. If they slide to play a ball, they cannot make contact with an opposing player without committing a foul.
- No Offside.

TBKC HIGH SCHOOL 3v3 SOCCER (continued)

- **Goal Scoring:** To score a goal, you must be on the offensive half of the field when you kick (touch) the ball, and the ball must completely cross the goal line.
- **Penalty Kicks:** If in the referee's opinion a scoring opportunity was nullified by an infraction, he can award a penalty kick. It is a direct kick taken from the middle of the invisible halfway line, with all the players 5 meters behind the ball.
- **Five Yard Rule:** In all dead ball situations, the defending players must stand at least five yards from the ball.
- **Kick Off:** To start from the imaginary halfway line and may be kicked any direction.
- **Indirect Kicks:** All dead ball kicks are indirect kicks (free kicks, goal kicks, kick offs). Exception: corner kicks and penalty kicks
- **Goal Kick:** May be taken from any point along the goal line.
- **Kick-Ins/Throw-ins:** The ball shall be kicked in or thrown in to restart play from the touchline. Must be played by another player before entering the goal.
- **Corner Kicks:** This is a direct kick taken from the corner of the goal line and touchline.
- **Substitutions:** Substitutions occur on the fly, whether ball is in play or not. Substitute must exit at the substitution zone prior to the player coming on entering via the substitution zone.
- **Goal Box:** Ten feet wide and six feet long directly in front of the goal. No player can touch the ball in that area. Any player may move through that marked area, but not touch the ball. If a defender touches the ball inside the area, it is counted as a goal. If an offensive player touches the ball, it is a goal kick for the defense. If the ball comes to a complete stop in the goal box, it is a goal kick for the defense.
- **Imaginary Halfway Line:** Divides the field evenly in length.
