50% Capacity Rule

You can indeed use all 8 fields. The players/athletes wouldn't need to be considered in the capacity.

Social distancing would apply to the spectators. If there are bleachers or grandstands, then capacity would need to be limited to 50% of seating capacity. If spectators are sitting on grass/in lawn chairs the proclamation says the venue can be open to "a number that permits social distancing" – which is six feet apart.
