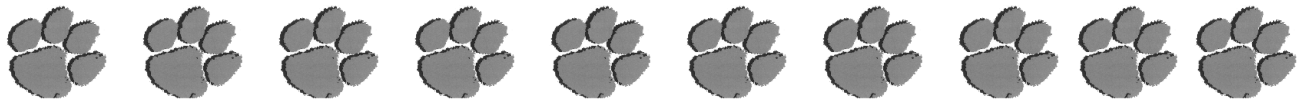


2019 WILDCAT SOFTBALL CLINICS



The Linfield College Softball Program is conducting two instructional All-Skills Fastpitch clinics for girls ages 8-18 on January 19th and January 26th. All the clinic instruction will be provided by the coaches and players of the Linfield College Wildcats, one of the most consistently successful softball programs in the country. The Linfield College softball program has compiled 12 Northwest Conference Championships, 14 trips to the NCAA Playoffs, 12 National Top 15 Finishes, and an overall record of 580-133-1 since 2004 including NCAA Division III National Championships in 2007 and 2011. The Wildcats have seen 31 players receive NFCA All-American recognition during that time while leading the entire nation in homeruns in 2010, 2011, and 2012. The 2018 team finished the year ranked in the top 10 nationally in Batting Average, Slugging Percentage, Homeruns, and Stolen Bases.

Each clinic will stress the skills and fundamentals that are necessary to be successful at any level of competition. The skills covered will include hitting, bunting, baserunning, and fundamental defensive play for infield and outfield. There will also be time for pitchers and catchers to learn from the Wildcat coaches and pitching staff. For girls ages 13-18 both clinics will also feature a post-clinic talk about developing success skills on and off the softball field and a question and answer session where clinic attendees can ask questions about college and the softball recruiting process.

DATE: January 19th, 2019 **OR** January 26th, 2019

TIME: 10:00 am – 3:00 pm for campers ages 8-12 and from 10:00-4:00 for campers ages 13-18 with a one hour break for lunch (approximately 12:00-1:00). Lunch is **NOT** included with the clinic so please bring a sack lunch or plan on purchasing lunch. If interested you may eat lunch in Dillin Hall (our college cafeteria) with some of our Wildcat Softball players but it must be paid for separately on the day of the clinic.

EQUIPMENT: Bring all your necessary softball equipment: gloves, bats, batting helmets, workout appropriate clothes, etc. If you do not have a bat or batting helmet we will provide one for you. All campers should bring cleats and a sweatshirt/jacket as we will be outside for defense and baserunning drills as the weather allows.

COST: \$65.00 per camper for ages 13-18, \$45.00 per camper for ages 8-12.

CLINIC CAPACITY: Each clinic is limited to 96 Total Registrants (24 in each age group) so register early!
