

Mt Pleasant Palmetto Shootout Code of Conduct

Only the team spokesman and referee on the field will discuss any questions or disputes. Disputes will not be heard after the game. The Mt Pleasant Palmetto Shootout reserves the right to disqualify any team for infractions of the following policies:

- **Use of Illegal Players:** The players listed on the roster at the time the roster is submitted are the only players eligible to play.
- **False Information:** Any false information provided on your entry form/roster is grounds for disqualification.
- **Unnecessary vulgarity or abrasive conduct:** Good sportsmanship is expected. Spirit of the Game is expected as well. The Mt Pleasant Palmetto Shootout reserves the right to immediately terminate a game and/or a player, coach or spectator from the premises.

COACHING: All coaches have total responsibility for the conduct of their players, assistant coaches, parents, friends and spectators at all times. Coaching from the sideline (giving direction to one's own team on points of strategy and position) is permitted, provided:

- The tone of the voice is instructive and not derogatory;
- Each coach or assistant remains on their own half of the field between the substitution area and restraining line.
- No Coach, assistant or spectator makes derogatory remarks or gestures to the officials (referees), other coaches, players or spectators;
- No coach, assistant or spectator uses profanity or incites, in any manner, disruptive behavior.
