*** Note:** This is a USSA Sanctioned Event – **USSA Equipment rules apply.** (U16's and U19's, check with your local shop and within your team to rent or borrow a SG appropriate ski, one which complies with the length/radius requirements listed below, if you don't own one. There are a lot of 30-meter skis out there, so it shouldn't be too hard to find one.)

U14 – USSA specification for Super G is **no min** length with a 17m minimum turning radius.

U16 – USSA specification for Super G is 183cm length with a 30m minimum turning radius.

U19 – USSA specification for Super G is 183cm length with a 30m minimum turning radius.

*** Note:** Entrants **must** have their coach's recommendation to attend. Notice of acceptance will be provided after verification with the coach

*Minimum of 60 participants for event to be held
