## Gridiron Minutes – Oct. 17, 2017

**Meeting called to order at:** 6:35 p.m. by President Rick Bouchard

A motion was made to waive reading of minutes; Tito Roderick and Ron Pastor approved.

**Coach's Corner:** *Coach Mike Drury reported*

- Coach Drury reported that we are coming off a bye week and into the Conference Championship game against New Britain.
