Updates from Boosters Programs

Another suggestion is to get kids to sign up at awards night for the following year to get commitment. Suggestions will be considered and discussed at a future meeting.
- **FOOTBALL:** Mike provided an update. First flag football game is this Sunday at the Gouin Field under the lights. Homecoming is October 1st @ 1pm. FB and cheerleaders will be marching. Punt Pass Kick fundraiser on September 24th.
- **SIDELINE CHEERING:** Season is going well. Teams enjoyed their first game despite the rain. Team pictures will happen this week and we will be finishing up our Amato's Coupon book fundraiser at the end of September.
- **BASKETBALL:** Plans are in place to bring Boosters and travel teams together. Joe plans to stick with format of playing games on weeknights and practices on weekends. He received overwhelmingly positive feedback from parents on this format last year. Joe would like to do candy bars for winter fundraiser for a 2-4 week period. Mike suggested running the fundraiser 2 weeks before and 2 weeks after Christmas. Joe will make a decision at a later date.
- **WRESTLING:** Wrestling will be doing a fundraiser on October 15th from 7am – 10am – toll booth at South Paris Dunkin Donuts.

Old Business

- Apparel
 - Will not be doing an order through Maine St. Supply this year.
 - Kate will open apparel store through Squad Locker for fall season but will look into other vendors as well for future stores.

New Business

- Viking Charge 5k – registrations are down significantly and more volunteer help is needed to make this event successful. In order to avoid a potential loss of funds, Mike made a motion to cancel Viking Charge 5k for 2016, Joe seconded, AIF. Will revisit for next year.
- Received a request for a \$300 donation to Harrison Halloween walk. This event doesn't fall within our purview. Joe made a motion to deny request, Mike seconded, AIF.



- Mike announced that he is now part of an ad-hoc committee meeting on athletic expectations for the district which involves repairing relationship between Boosters and school department. School department policy states that the district will handle grades 7-12 and Boosters will handle grades K-6. Mike is working closely with AD and superintendent to repair relationship.
