




# Meals for McMahan:

Using local restaurants to feed those in need

## What is Meals for McMahan?

The Coronavirus pandemic and quarantine has put great strain on our community. Working families, students, and local businesses have all been impacted. **Meals for McMahan** is a program designed to bring some small degree of relief to all three of these affected groups.

## How does it work?



Four local restaurants have stepped forward to prepare and deliver food to our student's families that are in need. The way that it works is that those that are willing to make a donation call one of the restaurants listed below and say they are **calling on behalf of "Meals for McMahan."** The restaurant will ask you how much money you would like to contribute and take your credit card information to complete the transaction. It is as if you are purchasing a gift certificate over the phone.

These funds will be held by the restaurant in an account they've created expressly for the purpose of **"Meals for McMahan."** The restaurant will record the name of the donor. If they wish to remain anonymous, that is completely fine as well. Weekly the restaurant will report to Coach Q the amount of money that is available in the "Meals for McMahan" account. The restaurant will prepare wholesome meals and deliver them to families that are in high need.
