

Black Hills Lacrosse Association Registration Policy

Registration Policy

Black Hills Lacrosse has prepared this policy to provide a comprehensive structure for the registration process. Black Hills Lacrosse intends to make the process clear, accurate and fair to all as many participants as is reasonable without creating an undue burden on the Registrar, Equipment Coordinator, or Coaches.

Registration Requirements to Be an Eligible Participant

- All participants shall have their registration complete prior to participation in an association event. Registration fees, birth certificates, the volunteer policy and related waivers must be signed and returned before participation will be allowed.
- If all of the above requirements are not met, the participant will be considered ineligible to participate in practices or games until the registration requirements are met in full.

General Registration

General Registration will begin no earlier than November 1st and end on the last day of February.

- Registration will be completed online through the BHLA website.
- No participant in possession of equipment from any prior year will be allowed to register until either the equipment is returned, or payment is made to cover the costs of replacement.
- No participant with monies owed to the association from any prior year will be allowed to register until payment is made for the outstanding debt.

Late Registration

- Any registration after the close of general registration is subject to a late fee.
- Late fees will be determined by the BHLA Board.
- Late registration makes it difficult on BHLA and its other members.
 - Players registered after March 1st may not be eligible to participate in competition if season rosters have already been completed.
 - All registration requirements must be met prior to March 1st to avoid late registration fees and possible ineligibility from competition.
