



Lakers Junior Lacrosse: Privacy Policy

Policy Overview

This Privacy Policy describes how Lakers Junior Lacrosse (LJL) uses and protects information you provide to LJL when you or your child registers for or otherwise participates in our program(s). This Privacy Policy applies solely to information collected and stored by Lakers Junior Lacrosse.

Minimum Information

We only request and store the minimum amount of information required to deliver our programs.

3rd Party Disclosure

We do not provide your personal information to third parties. LJL may use your personal information in the form of aggregate statistics or anonymized data which do not identify individuals.

Voluntary Disclosure to 3rd Parties

You may voluntarily choose to *directly* provide your personal information to a 3rd party in order to participate in or acquire non-LJL activities, services and/or products. (e.g. US Lacrosse registration, PayPal, vendor sites, social media sites, etc.)

Disclosure to Other LJL Members

Contact information (phone, email, social media ID) will be used solely for the purpose of facilitating emergency communications or to communicate logistical information associated with LJL programs. In cases of coordination and logistics, only the minimum necessary information to establish contact will be shared with the coach(es) of each your players' team(s). A team list with parent phone/email may be shared with all players who are part of the same team or program. Some of your contact information may be shared with other members of our Board of Directors as required to inform you of LJL programs or events.

Media Use

Lakers Junior Lacrosse reserves the absolute right and permission to use its members' likenesses in photographs, video, broadcast, published or copyrighted and use pictures of its members in which they may be included in whole or in part, composite or retouched in character or form, without payment or any other consideration. LJL further reserves the absolute right to edit, alter copy, exhibit, publish or distribute photographs and videos of its members for informational, educational, promotional, disciplinary or publicity purposes concerning LJL and its programs.

Protection

Lakers Junior Lacrosse takes precautions to protect our members' information.



All of our information is protected both online and off-line through the use of standard, generally accepted information security practices. Lakers Junior Lacrosse encourages members to familiarize themselves, not only with this Privacy Policy, but also to review and understand the privacy policies and information collection practices of other websites and 3rd party providers. While LJJL conducts cursory due diligence when providing links to external content and information, we are not responsible for the practices of other sites as they apply to privacy, security, integrity and compliance.
