Go to your team page by selecting the Teams tab | CHOOSE A TEAM | <Division> | <Team_Name>

Then select Teams | Results

On the Actions column select the Statistics button (Highlighted Green below)

Here is a breakdown of the different columns we care about for pitching (you can “mouse-over” the different ones to see what they are”

Atn = Participated in Game

PT = Pitches Thrown

PC Met = Previous Threshold was met while pitching to final batter (remember this rule) So if the started the last batter at 19 pitches but through 5 pitches to the batter you would put 24 in the PT column but then select the box.

Click on Save.

Then select Teams | Pitchers report. You can change the team selection and just chose the division to see all the pitchers available. I falsified some data for the next screen shot to show what it will look like.

As you can see in the above example, Michael Bartek Pitches says 24***. This is because I selected the PC Met option, showing that although he threw more than 20 pitches he did not require any additional days rest.

Also note that you DO NOT need to be logged in to see the data (Pitchers report" but I can change that if needed. You do need to be logged in to edit any of it.
