PLAYER COVENANTS

- Players will be fully dressed with skates on 15 minutes prior to ice time for all practices, and possibly sooner, for games at the discretion of the Coach.
- 2. It is the member's responsibility to notify the coach if he/she will miss a practice or game.
- If a member has been away, it is his/her responsibility to check with the team coordinator for new or revised schedules as well as anything that they have missed.
- C.C.Y.H.A., Inc. will not tolerate cursing or abusive language or behavior at any time from a member of the organization or coach. All violations will be brought before the Board of Directors.
- 5. Locker rooms will be open. Parents may be asked to leave for pre-game or post-game talks.
- 6. Assistance by parents at practices will be at the Head Coach's discretion. However, no one may assist on ice without first completing a USA Hockey Coaches IMR form to assure insurance protection is guaranteed. CCYHA will pay for the IMR of the Head Coach and up to 2 Assistants per team. All other Assistants will have to pay their own IMR fees unless waived in advance by the Board of Directors.
- 7. If a Player is involved in fighting or intent to injure on or off the ice:

First offense = one game benched (must dress and sit on bench)

Second offense = three games benched (must dress and sit on bench)

Third offense = suspension of one month with appeal to the Board of Directors.

- Players are responsible for damages caused by their actions which are charged to the Club. This Includes damage to locker rooms or any other facilities.
- An Appeal to a Connecticut Hockey Conference (CHC) suspension must be made within 24 hours
 of the occurrence. A fee of \$25.00, payable by the member who is suspended, is payable to the
 CHC when filing an Appeal.
- 10. Players, or any other member of the C.C.Y.H.A., Inc. upon evidence of conduct detrimental to the welfare and honor of the C.C.Y.H.A., Inc. may be dropped from the Association by a two-thirds vote of the Board of Directors. No registration fee will be refunded if a player or member is dismissed from the C.C.Y.H.A., Inc.
