**PLAYER EVALUATIONS**

Player Evaluations are intended to rate a player's ability and are used as the basis for selecting players for teams. All players are evaluated and advanced to a Minor or Major League team through a draft process after completion of the skills evaluation. Coaches will notify parents regarding the selection of their child. All players hoping to advance to a Major League team **MUST** participate in the Skills Evaluation process. No player will be advanced to the Minor or Major Leagues against his or her parents wishes except when a players age requires it. There is also no guarantee of a spot on a Minor or Major League roster. **All players, regardless if they have already been assigned to a team will be required to participate in evaluations.**

**SNACK STAND**

One major source of our funding is revenue generated by our snack stand. Running the snack stand requires parents, grand-parents and even older siblings to step-up and volunteer their time during games to operate the stand. Please make sure you check with your Team Mom at the beginning of the season so that you can sign up to help operate the stand throughout the season.

HKHS students can use their Snack Stand time toward required community service time. **Volunteering at the snack stand is a requirement for each player’s family who plays at the Great Hill Complex.**

**PLAYER EQUIPMENT & UNIFORMS**

All equipment is provided by the league. All players receive a hat, uniform jersey and baseball socks which they can keep at the end of the season. Parents and players are responsible for providing their own glove, cleats and gray pants. Gray pants is the approved color. Black, white or any other color pant can be worn for practice only. Little League Baseball has restrictions on what type of bats can be used in each division. **BACKGROUND CHECKS**

As required by Little League International, anyone who comes into contact with any of the players in the league must complete a background check form. Background check forms will be available at all of the registration sessions and will require a photocopy of a valid drivers license. All background checks are completed by the league at no charge.
