- **Volunteer Applications:** Currently, we have over 120 approved volunteers. Thank you to those that have submitted your forms and are out on the field helping out the teams. CBSL has a requirement for 100% compliance for background checks. Little league and CBSL officers will be starting to audit teams at the fields for non-approved volunteers. If you have anyone outstanding, please get their forms filled out and submitted to Chris Ferrante via email at president@cbsl.org. The form for new applicants requires the inclusion of the applicant SSN to complete the process.
- **Memorial Day Weekend activities:** Every year, CBSL marches in the Memorial Day parade. All teams meet in the WJJMS parking lot no later than noon. Parade begins at 12:30pm. The CBSL participant dismissal point is at the Town Green. American flags to waive are encouraged.
- **Memorial Weekend Games & Activities:** See your Division Coordinators to discuss the specifics planned for each division following the Parade.
- **CBSL Picture Day:** Has been rescheduled for Sunday, May 22. Schedule will be released shortly; make up games need to be scheduled first to ensure no conflicts in schedule. - **2016 Tournament Team Updates:** CBSL requires all players eligible for tournament teams must participate in 60% of their regular season games and complete/sign the tournament team eligibility form to be considered. More information will be available during division meetings and through email / web-based information. Any manager / coach interested in being considered for a tournament team coaching spot need to submit their interest for consideration no later than 5/31.
- **Field Conditions:** Reminder – all team managers, coaches and parent volunteers are required to rake the fields before and after all practices and games, to continue to ensure high quality field conditions. This only works if every team is following this policy.
- **General Reminders:**
 - Conduct – All participants are expected to abide by the terms within their respective code of conduct. Managers are responsible for team compliance for all players and coaches. Only managers are permitted to discuss non-judgment calls with the umpires. Comments and criticisms regarding judgment calls (fair, foul, safe, out, ball and strike) are not permitted or to be tolerated.
 - End of Day / Night Checks – please remember to check all sheds and fields for equipment left behind or not put away. Verify all sheds are locked and all dugouts/fields are clean and free of trash before leaving.
