Waive the reading of the Treasurer's report. As the treasurer is not present. Levine brought up discussing the process of selecting managers and players for the tournament team. Gatesman said any manager or assistant coach can be considered as manager for a team. Manager candidates are due by June 1.

Anderson said some Bacon JV players are now eligible and need to play 60 percent of the remaining games. Levine said pool play to start the tournament does not count toward the 60 percent.

A reminder that all levels of baseball and softball is pool play.

Sunday is parade day. Softball will lead the contingent. Lineup is at the far right of the WJJMS parking lot. Coaches and parents must arrange for pickup at the end of the parade.

Levine reminded coaches that they should show respect and decorum during tournament games, especially toward an umpire. Questions to the umpire should be made respectfully and in a conversation, not across the field.

There was a discussion about the amount of rainouts, and attempting to get all baseball games in by June 15.
