

Rink Rules

We are very lucky to call the beautiful Jackman Stewart Rink at Berkshire School our home ice. We would like to remind everyone that we are guests in this facility and hope you will all help us maintain this great relationship by following the guidelines below. Parents please review these rules with your own children and help to enforce them not only with Rattlers skaters but with visiting teams as well.

1. Basic Rules:

- No stick handling anywhere in the building
- No soccer balls, lacrosse sticks, and balls
- No running around the building (you can use the track around the west rink)
- No food in the bench area
- No one is allowed on the ice until the Zamboni doors are closed
- The fitness center is for the Berkshire School community only
- You may not use the Rapid Shot or any fitness equipment on the upper deck
- The function room and press box are off limits
- Tobacco products and vaping equipment are not allowed in the building or on the grounds
- No dogs/pets in the building
- The elevator is not a toy and should only be used by those who need it
- All children not on the ice must be supervised

2. Please do not park cars in front of the building. Stopping to unload is fine but vehicles must be moved ASAP to keep the fire lane clear of traffic. No vehicle should be left unattended in the road in front of the building. There are parking lots in front, along the entrance drive, and directly behind the building.

3. When locker rooms are provided, please use them. Using the entrance area to change limits the seating and walking room for the next teams entering/exiting the building.
