I voluntarily seek facilities provided by South Windsor Parks & Recreation and acknowledge that I am increasing my risk of exposure to the Coronavirus/COVID-19. I acknowledge that I must comply with all set procedures to reduce the spread while utilizing South Windsor Parks and Recreation facilities

I hereby attest that:

- ✓ I have received a copy of the CT DECD Sector Rules for return to play entitled "Sports, Sports Clubs & Complexes, Gyms, Fitness Centers, & Pools" (Sports Sector Rules).
- ✓ I have provided an accompanying COVID plan specific to our organization's use of permitted Parks & Recreation facilities to define accountability for compliance with all current public health protocol as outlined in Sports Sector Rules.
- ✓ I have been informed of the following pertaining to the coronavirus:
 1. People who are 65 years and older and people of any age who have serious underlying medical conditions or are at higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19 are recommended to stay at home. A list of medical conditions associated with a higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19 can be found in CDC's guidance. Individuals and families should consult their healthcare provider to determine whether they have medical conditions that place them at risk.

2. Staff and children living in households with individuals who are 65 years and older OR have higher risk for severe illness from COVID-19 are recommended to stay home.

- ✓ By signing this document I agree to comply with all CT DECD Sector Rules for return to play entitled "Sports, Sports Clubs & Complexes, Gyms, Fitness Centers, & Pools" and all CT Executive Orders issued in 2020 including but not limited to social gatherings, social distancing, sanitation, and facemask use. Identified individuals, groups or teams failing to do so will result in prohibition for continued participation for the current season.

I hereby release and agree to hold the Town of South Windsor and its Parks and Recreation department harmless from, and waive on behalf of myself, my heirs, and any personal representatives, any and all causes of action, claims, demands, damages, costs, expenses and compensation for damage or loss to myself and/or property that may be caused by any act, or failure to act of the Town of South Windsor, CT, or that may otherwise arise in any way in connection with any services received from or any participation in conjunction with and South Windsor Parks and Recreation program. I understand that this release discharges South Windsor Parks and Recreation from any liability or claim that I, my heirs, or any personal representatives may have against the Town of South Windsor with respect to any bodily injury, illness, death, medical treatment, or property damage that may arise from, or in connection to, any services received from South Windsor Parks and Recreation. This liability waiver and release extends to the Town of South Windsor together with all Town employees.
