

# **Lacrosse Board Meeting on January 11, 2016**

## **Registration:**

- a few new players will be joining the boys team.
- Registration- 117 last year: 118 current year
- Registration numbers- boys: 77 boys last year: 71 current year
- Registration girls- 47 girls last year: 40 girls current year

## **Budget:**

- Current: \$82,081/ past: \$74,278
- DHS: \$45,876/\$38,032
- DLA has a healthy account, yet needs to pay fees for the season.
- At the end of the season board should look at the budget and discuss ways to pass along the saving to parents. Possible- drop the fees for younger players
- DLA fees similar to other clubs
- Scholarships available- just email Dan.
- High School- same uniforms as last year. Uniforms are about \$75.00 per player. School will pick up ref fees- high school will pick up that fee, yet they will get the ticket sales.

## **Uniforms for DLA:**

- Good quality
- The uniforms came a little smaller (cut and sew). About an inch smaller than initially reported. Changed on the website. Uniforms for the players are the correct size and will be available for the beginning of the season- January.
- Balance due is \$1,500
- The batch of shorts that had to be sewed again are now available to purchase at a discount. Discussion on the

price DLA is willing to pay for the shorts (\$5.00-\$7.00 each)

- The company that supplies DLA the uniforms would like testimonials from parents, players, etc.
- Girls will receive their uniforms at the first practice- January 18.

### **Equipment and Fields:**

- DLA does not have a person responsible for the fields, yet Todd set it up and Dan completed other tasks. Rain is a concern due to El Nino. The question was raised if the schools follow the same rules as the city for closing the fields.
- Equipment manager: Aaron will stay as long as he can train someone to take over. There was a discussion about Joey taking over the job and getting a stipend. One important aspect of the job is to log/keep track of what is borrowed, especially the helmets.
- Goals: Dan M. has rekeyed the goals. All board members have a key. Dan checked all the of the nets and goals.
- All board members should complete the Level 1 coaching training. Mark Reno will send out the link.
- Coaches bag: There was a discussion about the coaches bags which included what should be in the bags (medical kit, pennies, medical releases). It was said that it is the registrar's responsibility to gather all the information about allergies, etc. and it is the responsibility of the team manager to get that information to the coaches. Cliff does not have the coaches bags.
- The key to the storage shed was given to Dan and Paul W. by Dina.
- Two small cages at Willet need to go to Koromotsu by February 1.

- High School game goals are at the high school and are unassembled.
- We have enough balls to begin the season.
- Timing boxes need to be done before the timing class.
- DLA would like to purchase seven tables (three for the girls and four for the boys) and two chairs for each table. Dan will talk to Tom to figure out who should make these purchases.
