### Facility Use Agreement - COVID-19 January 2021 Addendum

- Rink Capacity: Maximum of 32 players (plus 4 coaches) on the ice at one time. Allowing for split team or full team practices.
- Games with teams from within the Fairbanks Northstar Borough
  - Maximum of 32 players on the ice, 2 referees calling the game, 2 coaches per bench, and 2 score keepers.
  - No teams competing from outside the Borough.
- Team areas will be staged at opposite sides of the arena for getting skates on.
- Teams will also be given additional bench seating to promote social distancing during gameplay.
- Visiting team will dress on the West end of the rink, and use a separate entrance to the rink. Visiting fans will have designated seating spaces.
- Limit of 2 family members per game participant, for a maximum of 64 people watching socially distanced and masked in stands.
- Spectators for each team will be separated in the bleachers by a whole section.
- Clusters will not be allowed, including by the arena main doors nearest the Skate Room
- Home teams are responsible for visiting team compliance and communication of mitigations.

### What you can expect from Patty Ice Arena staff:

- All handles and doors to be cleaned after every ice.
- Stick and puck will be allowed with social distancing and no contact.
- Sanitizer stations will be placed at front and back entrances.
- Patrons enter one door and exit the other side of the arena in order to facilitate an appropriate patron spacing.
- Benches will be spaced for patrons to apply skates before entering onto the ice. Benches will be sprayed down after every reservation.
- Only individuals and parents/guardians of minors using the ice during reservations will be allowed access to the facility.
- Masks required for spectators/coaches, not for skaters.
- Spectators will be required to maintain a minimum of 6' apart in the stands.
- Reservations will be offset by 30 minutes to allow proper time to disinfect.

If an organization is found to be not following the mitigation plans and positive cases result, the organization may be responsible for costs related to closing, cleaning and lost revenue.
