



2021 Registration FAQ's

Can I pay my registration fees online?

Yes! MGSA is proud to offer online payments for registration.

Is there a fee for online payments?

No, there are no additional online payment fees this year.

Will you be doing any in-person registration sessions?

We are currently not planning any in-person registration events for this season. We recommend using the on-line registration program or you may download the registration forms and mail them to us. Links to the forms can be found on the MGSA home page.

What is MGSA's COVID-19 risk mitigation plan?

MGSA works closely with the Morton Park District and Morton School District for COVID-19 protocols. As we begin the season, we will communicate expectations and guidelines for the season to our MGSA families. We are proud of our successful season last summer amidst the pandemic and are committed to repeating that performance again this year!

Can non-residents still participate this year? Is there a different registration program or fee for non-residents?

Yes, non-residents are still welcome to participate this season! This year, there will be no separate registration program for a non-resident participant. Even better, no additional fees! All players will be the same price regardless of residency.

Do I get a discount for having more than one player participate this season?

This year we have removed the multiple player discount and reduced the fees for all players.

I am planning to be a coach for my child's team, do I still have to pay my child's registration fee?

Yes, fees must still be paid at the time of registration. If selected to coach (either as a head coach or assistant coach), you will be reimbursed by MGSA at the coach's meeting.

When will the season start?

Practices are tentatively expected to start the week of April 26th, and games in late May.

What can I do to get more involved with the MGSA organization?

MGSA is ran by volunteers, and all help is always welcome! We can use assistance in many different areas of the organization including marketing, scheduling, field maintenance, and concessions, just to name a few. Our concession stand is our biggest source of revenue and is also our biggest need for help. We ask all parents to work at least one shift in the concession stand throughout the season. We are also in need of help running the concession stand outside of games, such as reordering inventory and picking up supplies.
