

Return to Play Protocols for McLean Youth Squash - 2020-2021 Season

Pre-Practice - Coaches and Players

1. Prior to attending any training session, each player should check his or her temperature at home and refrain from participation if he/she has a fever of >100.4 degrees. Temperatures will be taken at the courts before athletes start practice.
2. Prior to participation, coaches will obtain verbal confirmation from the player that:
 - a. The player has not had any contact with a sick individual or anyone with a confirmed case of COVID-19.
 - b. The player has not had a documented case of COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
 - c. The player is not demonstrating or suffering from any illness symptoms.
 - i. If the player answers YES to any of the above questions or has a temperature >100.4, that player will leave the facility immediately, and may not participate.

Onsite Protocols - Players

- All players must wait to enter the courts until a coach performs the pre-practice screen (listed above) - includes temperature check
- All players must enter and leave the courts at an appropriate distance from other family groups
- All players must wear a face mask or shield on the premises and on and off court
- Players please maintain a distance of 6 feet between each other and the coaches
- No sharing of equipment
- Hand sanitizer is provided. Players must use it before entering and after exiting the court
- No physical contact, e.g. hand shakes, high fives, fist bumps

Onsite Protocols - Coaches

- Coaches wear a mask or face shield at all times
- Coaches should use hand sanitizer regularly and encourage players to do the same
- Coaches wipe court door handles and frames with virus-killing solution before and after practices
- No physical contact with athletes
- Remind players to put on face masks/shields and maintain proper distance

Protocols - Parents/Families/Spectators

- All spectators (e.g. families and parents) must wear a face mask or shield at ALL TIMES inside the facility
- Spectators maintain the required distance from other family groups

Notification

- A coach or player who participates in a practice and receives a positive COVID-19 test within 14 days AFTER the game date should communicate the information to the MYA Squash Chair so all in attendance can be notified.

Failure to Follow Established Protocols

If a participant does not follow the above protocols and a coach thinks that the participant is risking his or her safety and/or the safety of the other participants, coaches or spectators, the following will occur:

1. The offender will have two minutes from the coach's initial warning to remediate their behavior.
2. If the behavior is not remediated after two minutes, the offending participant will be suspended until they agree to remediate their behavior
3. If the offensive behavior continues, practice will be terminated
