TREASURER REPORT

Kudos to Cindy Stutz! Cindy participates in the grant matching program at her work. From all Cindy's volunteer hours with PRCPA, her company donated \$750 to PRCPA. Awesome job Cindy!!!!

PRCPA has \$5685.32 left in the general account. Since we need to carry \$2000 over to next year that leaves us \$3685.32 for the End Of Year Banquet and senior gifts.

The Comp Team has \$698.03 and needs to carry \$200 over to next year.

THINKING ABOUT NEXT YEAR

Concessions- Next year there is a total of five home football games. The money made at the concessions benefits all cheer teams. In lieu of donations, PRCPA is planning on collecting a \$50 concession fee per family. This will eliminate having to run items to the stadium and ensure that we have enough food as well as the required Pepsi products for each game.

Volunteers- This organization is constantly challenged with getting volunteers. Our two major fundraisers are Cheer Clinic and the Concessions stand. We were throwing out some possible ideas to remedy this issue. In years past, Varsity handled Cheer Clinic while JV and MS did the concessions. Thinking this might make it easier for all.

Board Structure- Looking at two Co-President's-One Comp & One Non-Comp, Vice-President, Secretary and Two Co-Treasurer's-One Comp & One Non-Comp. No team moms.

Cheer Camp- There was discussion about the running a Summer Cheer Mini Camp in conjunction with Coach Kasperowicz's Youth Football Camp" the week of June 12-15. This is the 22nd year of the EK Camp and a great way to tap into a fundraising opportunity for PRCPA. Thinking maybe two days from 9am-noon. The girls would be teaching cheer skills to the younger girls (Youth Rams) who would receive a Rams tank top, etc. It's a great way to keep the younger girls interested in cheer. Also, most cheerleaders need volunteer hours for Key Club or National Honor Society. NA does a camp for 5 days a week in the summer and makes \$100 per girl. This is a great opportunity to raise money but we will need volunteers to execute it and make it successful!
