Sideline Report

- Kate Eyerman reviewed community service opportunities for the cheerleaders. 3 projects were approved by Coach Berezo and are awaiting school district approval:
 - Ice cream social at St. Barnabus in late November or December;
 - Hat and Glove collection at Schools for the homeless;
 - Presents for Paws – animal shelter in West Deer in March.

- Community service is not mandatory for cheerleaders. The goal is to participate in at least 1 opportunity. Includes all levels of Sideline and Competition.

Fundraiser Report

- Liz Leight provided lessons learned from this past concession season:
 - Food runners have worked well to collect concessions from local retailers prior to game;
 - More than 1 person is needed to run concessions;
 - Purchasing supplies via Amazon may be more efficient and less costly;
 - If volunteers cancel they must find their own replacement;
 - Enforce 18 and older age restrictions;
 - There was a mouse problem this year due a hole in the ceiling. The hole was fixed but the problem persisted;
 - End the storage of field hockey equipment in the concession stand.
- Jen Campbell displayed the wreath fundraiser that will be offered to the boosters. The price is \$45 and cost is \$35 – boosters will earn \$10 for each wreath sold. Order form will be on the website. Orders will be required by November 18th.
- Competition Cheer will have a Dine-Out night at IHOP.
- Concession stand will be open for playoff game on November 8th. Coffee and popcorn will be donated. Attendees volunteered to purchase and provide hot dogs, soda and condiments. An email will be sent for other donations.

- The Board thanked all for a successful senior night. A special thanks for the center pieces and the locker decorations.
- The Board made a \$500 donation to Pillows for Patients in support of Shelby Petonak. The donation was voted and approved by the membership via Survey Monkey.
