ABOUT THE CAMP

We will be using the Middle School North for boy campers grades 1-9. During the morning session, time will be spent focusing on the development of individual skills. Campers will be instructed in all aspects of individual offensive and defensive basketball during teaching sessions. These stations will cover shooting, ball handling, passing, screening, and man-to-man defense. Following stations, campers will be shown how to properly practice during the fundamental practice session. This session demonstrates how to practice individually to improve important fundamentals to become better basketball players. League games, arranged by age groups, are devoted to developing the team concept and the incorporation of the skills learned during the teaching stations. Also, campers will compete in skills contests by age group.

TUITION

Tuition at the Groton Dunstable Basketball Camp is \$180.00 for registration received before the first day of camp. Tuition includes a camp shirt and basketball.

ABOUT THE DIRECTORS



Coach Gillette is entering his 7th year as Varsity Coach. He had previously served as assistant varsity/j.v. coach at GD the prior seven years after serving as Littleton Boy's Varsity basketball coach for 4 years Coach Gillette's teams have reached the districts 5 out of the last 6 years. The past two years his team reached the Clark Tournament and District Championship games. Coach Gillette has been named 2017 Lowell Sun Coach of the Year.



Coach Woods coached for 20 years, and was the head varsity basketball coach at Groton-Dunstable for 16 years. Coach Woods' varsity teams compiled a 227-120 record. Highlights as head coach include five Mid-Wach league championships, four Clark Large School Championships, three District Championships and three trips to the State Finals. His teams qualified for the Clark and Districts thirteen times in sixteen years. Coach Woods was named Lowell Sun "Coach of the Year" three times and Mass Basketball Coaches Association "Coach of the Year" twice. Member of the MBCA Victory Club.
