Dear Brewins Families,

Below are the details associated with jersey fittings for U6-U14 registered players:

**Fitting locations/dates:**

Pure Hockey - Kingston, MA July 8<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup>

Pure Hockey - Braintree, MA July 15<sup>th</sup> - 19<sup>th</sup>

**Store Hours:**

Mon - Friday 11am - 7pm

Saturday 9am - 6pm

Sunday 10am - 5pm

Pure Hockey is offering in-person jersey fittings for all players registered in the U6-U14 levels. All are urged to attend a fitting within the dates noted above to ensure proper jersey fit and lead time. When you arrive at Pure Hockey, please find a sales associate and let them know you are from Brewins Youth Hockey and you are there for a jersey fitting. Please be sure to bring your player(s) along with their shoulder and elbow pads. You will then be given information that records your players' jersey size and link to the Brewins online store. Following your fitting, you **must** log on to the Brewins online store to complete your order. Your socks, practice jersey, and game jersey should total \$0, but you will be charged accordingly for any additional purchases. In addition, you will receive a \$20 gift card. This gift card must be used in-store at one of the Pure Hockey locations and cannot be used for the Brewins online store. Shipping is free and the Brewins online store will be available from July 8th through July 19th.

When ordering your player's game jersey, you will be prompted to provide a jersey size, last name, and jersey number. We understand that numbers are important to players, and parents alike. Players that are new to the Brewins or that do not have an existing number or would like to change their existing number must select an available number based on their birth year. For example, a player born in 2014 must select an available 'even' number from 2-98. Likewise, for 'odd' birth years. Numbers will be available on a first-come, first-served basis, so if your player has a preferred number, please plan accordingly. As a suggestion, it's a good idea to have a few numbers in mind when ordering. Returning players are encouraged to select numbers within their birth year as referenced above, however, if a player wishes to keep a longstanding or existing number, you may do so based on availability. If a number appears to be 'unavailable' and is in conflict, please reach out to Tony Rego to discuss.
