## North Dakota Youth Soccer Association (NDYSA) Toyota State Tournament Rules

1. Basic rules for the NDYSA Toyota State Tournament are posted with Registration Form.
- 2. Registration of Age Groups U-10 thru U-13 will only be allowed for NDYSA Member Club teams. NO RECREATIONAL TEAMS ALLOWED.**
- 3. Registration of Age Groups U-14 thru U-19 will be open to all USSF Members and Canadian Soccer Association. NO RECREATIONAL TEAMS ALLOWED.**
4. Rules Specific to this Tournament are:
  - a. The tournament reserves the right to shorten or cancel games as deemed necessary.
  - b. All games will start on time, with forfeits being declared for any team not present within 10 minutes of scheduled game start time. The clock starts as of the scheduled time without regard to the circumstances regarding games on the field. Forfeits will be scored as a 1-0 victory.
  - c. There will be no protests or appeals of any kind allowed for a match. Decision of the referee is final.
  - d. During all preliminary rounds, ties will stand. Tournament points are awarded (or subtracted) as follows:

Win	6 points
Tie	3 points
Loss	0 points
Goals	1 point per goal, Max of three counted for Tournament points
Shutout	1 point
Red Card	1 point Deduction per red card in that match, Including Coach/Bench red cards
  - e. Within a division, standings will be determined based on the following criteria:
    - (1) Highest number of Tournament points
    - (2) Winner in head-to-head competition(unless more than two teams are tied.
    - (3) Goal differential: Goals scored minus goals allowed: Maximum goal differential of three points per match.
    - (4) Fewest goals allowed.
    - (5) Penalty kicks according to FIFA Kicks From the Mark except all players may be chosen to kick if this tie breaker is used.
      - (a) If three teams remain tied with tournament points, a random draw will be used to select two teams for Kicks From the Mark. The winner of this Kicks from the Mark will then participate in Kicks From the Mark with the team not selected in the random draw.
  - f. There will be no tie games in semi-final or championship matches. Two full 5-minute overtime periods will be played--NO GOLDEN GOAL. If teams are still tied after overtime periods then FIFA Kicks From the Mark will be used to determine winning team.
