**Financials:** Tim Cooper distributed the PCLI balance sheet and hard copies of the financial status to the coordinators that were present. Tim reviewed the report and what activity has occurred since the previous month.

Tim provided information clarifying the distribution of the funds for the women's fall and winter programs and tournaments. Tim also offered an explanation of how Pittsford Lacrosse has chosen to invest in the 1/2 programs in order to keep a wide funnel of players readily available and interested in lacrosse.
