The initiative is currently moving through the SEQRA process that will culminate with project and funding approval from the State Education Department. A fall referendum vote is possible.

CURE:

Discussion focused on how to increase awareness about the program and its involvement in the Pittsford Lacrosse Festival.

1. The CURE program provides players with a purpose to their playing
2. Game should be played against a natural rivalry to broaden awareness.
3. Program encourages a collaborative community effort focusing on one cause.
4. Programs to emulate include the Rainbow Classic and Pink the Rink. This year 1500 tickets were sold to attend Pick the rink hockey game.

Tish Romas coordinating effort with the PMHS and Sutherland design classes to produce the X Out Cancer t-shirts. The students are handling the design of the t-shirt, brochure and banner.

Brian Wirth, the Executive Director of CURE was present to discuss the efforts so far. \$9K has been collected from sponsors. Varsity uniforms have been purchased – shirts only. These will be able to be worn year over year. Reviews have been positive – they are very sharp. T-shirt logo design and advertisements are due this week.

Next step is to coordinate the donation program for the players.

There will be a boys vs. girls donations contest. 100% of the funds go to CURE!

A Pass the Bucket collection will be held during the Varsity Boys and Girls games.
