Boys Youth:

Winter Programming:

Girls Youth:

Fall

1. November Gobble Gobble Games – fun pickup style games with Fairport, HFL, and Victor for 3rd/4th and 5th/6th graders first 3 Sundays in November (6, 13, 20). Very successful! Good reviews from players, coaches, and parents. Everybody had fun. 26 Pittsford players. Would like

to do again next year and expand. Had issue with Irondequoit insurance. Need to figure out best and easiest way to ensure insurance coverage for non-PCLI members.

2. Winter

1. First two sessions of winter program included free clinic for beginning players. 19 registrants, of which 14 subsequently registered for regular program. Think this is a good model for future recruitment. A bit easier than trying to schedule and run a separate clinic.
2. Winter Program has 59 registrants, including 14 from the Beginners Clinic.
 1. K: 5
 2. 1: 6
 3. 2: 14
 4. 3: 5
 5. 4: 11
 6. 5: 8
 7. 6: 10
3. Want a second registration for last 7 sessions in January and February for those players (and coaches) who could not play in December and were not planning to register.

3. Spring

1. Starting discussions with other towns for plans for spring. RALL vs. non-RALL.
2. Planning a new K only program, in addition to standard grade levels 1-2, 3-4, and 5-6. Want to keep K separate from 1-2.
3. Expect to have 110-130 registrants. Have gone from 100 in spring 2014, to 76 in spring 2015, and 87 in spring 2016.
4. Looking to get new uniforms. Mike Camarella working on this.

4. Summer

1. Expect to have summer for 1-2. Not sure about K yet – depends on coaches. Hope to have for 3-4, but dependent upon coaches.

Coaches

1. Two coaches attended the US Lacrosse Level 1 instructional course on Sunday, November 13, at Mendon HS.
2. Level 2 course in Brighton on February 18. Hoping to get coaches to attend.
3. Recruiting coaches for K – plan to groom them to take over 1-2 group in 2017-2018 after Ashton Maaraba moves up.

Other Items

1. Purchased new goggles and sticks, both for lending and for resale. This is a BIG help for new players/families.
 1. Goggles - 15 for lending and resale

2. Sticks - 10 for lending
 3. Sticks - 20 for resale
 4. Team sales from Lax.com offers equipment at nice discounts - ~25%. Will use in future, unless we have other preferred vendor for equipment.
2. Might need more 4x4 goals as program grows. Can use popup goals for K.

Fundraiser parent mixer, parent has donated location all in planning mode.

Girls Scholastic: 65 girls attending winter. Girls Varsity is going to Westchester over spring break.
