

The following is a brief description of the volunteer opportunities available during registration. Assistant coaches are not listed on the registration. If you are interested in assisting your child's Head Coach, please contact the Executive Director and you will be put in touch with the appropriate board member.

Thank you for powering our club, Go Warriors!!

All Volunteer Descriptions in Black are Club Related. This means you may be working before the season rather than during game time and have duties that are not related to your child's team, but contribute to the overall health of our organization.

All Volunteer Descriptions in Blue are specific to your player's team and occur during the Spring season.

Team Manager:

Primary coordinator for all team activities. Recruits other team parents for key tasks and fills in where necessary. Assures coaches have necessary support. Is the primary contact person for the parents for any schedule changes and relays messages as necessary via email, web site and/or voice mail. Reports field usage, injuries and referees participation to Executive Director after each game. Assigns parents to assist with their home game duties for snacks, field set up and clean up. Informs parents of away game details, including driving directions, important for any traveling the team does during the season (away games, tournaments, playoff games).

Picture Day Coordinator

Work with chosen Photographer to secure a location (obtain permit for use), finalize contract, schedule teams for time slots, schedule make up day if necessary, and disseminate information to coaches, team managers and families. Pick up and distribute

pictures to team managers as needed. Must be available for picture day in March 2018 (exact date TBA). Mid season work.

Uniform Committee Members (Assistants)

Assist with sizing dates and assisting with sorting & distributing of uniforms. There are several positions available on this committee:

Spirit Wear Committee

Assist with onsite sales of spiritwear. Kick off –January 6th, 2018, Club day (tentative May 6th)

Club Day Assistant

Under the director of the Club Day coordinator. Coordinate vendors and additional events that take place on the annual Club Day (first Sunday of May). This season club day will be reformatted. This is an exciting opportunity to utilize your creativity in developing this event. Pre and midseason work.

Equipment Committee:

Work with the Club's Equipment Manager to open/close the storage facility during game weekends. Stock coaches' bags, move goals, and assist with maintaining the club's inventory. Pre, mid, and some post season work.

FUNDRAISING: Dine & Donate:

Secures fundraising dates with local vendors, circulate the information and fliers to club members, and follow up with vendors to collect funds. Potentially four – five dates per season. Pre and midseason work.

FUNDRAISING: Corporate Sponsorships:

Working with members of the Board of Directors to develop a plan and secure Corporate Sponsorships. Pre and midseason work.

FUNDRAISING: Special Events

Working with members of the Board of Directors to develop a plan and secure a major fundraising event. Pre and mid season work.

Special Events:

Plan and implement events such as going to college games. This position allows for creativity by the volunteer. Pre and mid season work.

High School and College Liaison:

Maintain open lines of communication with all high school coaches. Establish game nights at local events, possible half time activities.

Social Media Coordinator

Responsible for content of the social media websites (currently Facebook, Instagram, others if interested). Responsible for a minimum of three weekly postings plus announcements. Year long position. (filled for 2018)

TEAM VOLUNTEERS (sign up with your team manager at the beginning of the season). Check the 'Team Job' position during registration. 8U families, please note there are a very limited number of Team Jobs as there is no scorekeeping for games. We strongly encourage you to become involved with one of our club level activities! Team Volunteer Jobs consist of the following, there may be more or less depending on your Team's Manager:

- End of Year Party:
Confirm Party Location and Format, prizes, awards, thank you gifts, and food Separate Girls & Boys, game schedule, vendors, food, and raffles
- Volunteer Coordinator
Keeps records to guarantee all families are compliant with volunteer requirement. connect families with jobs to fulfill their volunteer requirement.
- Score Keeper
Keep Score at home games. As the 'away' team assist as a 'second chair'.
- Timer
At home games, maintain the timer and alert coaches and referees when time is ending.
- Sideline Manager (formerly Field Marshall)
Ensures that fans maintain positive behavior consistent with the principals of Positive Teaching. Also enforces permit rules. More information can be found on our league's website here:
