Pitch Counts:

Pitch Thresholds and Rest Requirements:

League Age	Maximum Pitches per Day
13-16	95
11-12	85
9-10	75
7-8	50

Age 14 and under
1-20 pitches: Can pitch the next day
21-35 pitches: 1 day of rest
36-50 pitches: 2 days of rest
51-65 pitches: 3 days of rest
66 or more pitches: 4 days of rest

Ages 15-16
1-30 pitches: Can pitch the next day
31-45 pitches: 1 day of rest
46-60 pitches: 2 days of rest
61-75 pitches: 3 days of rest
76 or more pitches: 4 days of rest

- Having reached a threshold, a pitcher may complete the at bat; if a pitcher reaches another threshold during that at bat, the higher threshold is recorded
- Having been removed as a pitcher, a pitcher may not return to pitch again on the same day
- A pitcher who delivers 41 or more pitches in a game cannot play the position of catcher for the remainder of that day
- Any player who has played the position of catcher in four or more innings in a game is not eligible to pitch on that calendar day.

Rookies Division Coach-Assisted Pitching:

There are no walks until after May 18th. The season will begin with “coach-assisted” pitching. When a pitcher throws four balls to a batter, a coach from the hitting team will take over and complete the at bat as pitcher. The strike count on the batter remains and the at bat continues until the batter strikes out (swinging or called) or the batter puts the ball in play. Coach-assisted pitching ends on May 18th and walks are then permitted in games.
