OLD BUSINESS:

Concessions update, Winterized completed

Capital Improvements discussed: Dugouts at Harbor Park not feasible due to security concerns of Middlesex Health employees use parking area, and enclosed dugouts would hamper security. Snow School field #2, suggested by Jen Lane some form of stairs from top of hill to field. New pitching machines, also storage facility at Harbor Park, shed recommended.
